Holy Week - Sunday, April 05 to Saturday, April 11

During Holy Week, Christians recall the events leading up to Jesus' death and His resurrection. We begin with Palm Sunday as Jesus begins his triumphal entry into Jerusalem and is honored with palm branches and praises of "Hosanna to the Son of David" "Blessed is the King of Israel". The rest of the week is remembered with sorrow as it leads to the crucifixion of Jesus. Maundy Thursday commemorates the washing of the feet and the last supper with the apostles at Passover, as Jesus gives them a new commandment "to love one another". Good Friday, a terrible day in itself, leads to the resurrection of Jesus and His victory over death and sin which we will celebrate on Easter Sunday.
